

**RISDON ZINC PROJECT**

<b>Client:</b>	Pasminco Metals-EZ	<b>Scope of Work</b>  The scope of work encompassed a series of design studies and construction projects for expansion of the Risdon Refinery to a nominal 320,000 t/a, including replacement of hydrometallurgical treatment plants and a new 100,000 t/a tankhouse.  <b>Flowsheet</b>  The modernisation programme took place over a period of almost 5 years, replacing obsolete plant, improving plant safety and hygiene and reducing operating costs. The output of the complex was increased to 215,000 t/a of metallic zinc.
